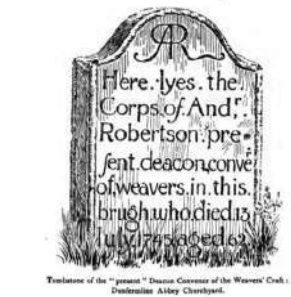


Gravestone photos crib sheet

	The stars are carved in relief (stand proud of stone surface) Letters and date are incised (cut into the stone).	 Facsimile of the "present" Staines Gravestone of the Weaver's Cofe: Dedicated to the Ashby Churchyard.	This drawing shows the dots used by letter cutters to get the right spacing in inscriptions		You can see the dots on this gravestone
	Here some letters are reversed and some joined together. This is more common on earlier stones.		Inscriptions may use initials not full names. Here initials are in relief & the date is incised.		Spacing not quite right spouse
	Lead letters were sometimes used on either granite or marble stones.		Victorian stones may use more than one lettering style. Gothic letters popular in print too	 	
	This 1616 stone has relief and incised lettering.		Stones may be carved with monograms (initials in fancy design) this one is the letter 'W'.
